The judges referred the involved lawyers to regulators and cautioned that future misuse could lead to prosecution.
- 2. <u>Move Over, Perry Mason</u> Enter Crosby, the Algorithm Lawyer : Sequoia-backed startup Crosby has launched as an Al-augmented law firm, blending proprietary software with in-house lawyers to deliver contract reviews for startups in under an hour, aiming to speed up negotiations and break one of the biggest bottlenecks in business growth.
- 3. Robo-Robe Judges Rock Arizona: The Arizona Supreme Court has debuted two Algenerated avatars, Daniel and Victoria, to quickly deliver and explain rulings to the public in an effort to boost trust and accessibility. Officials say the avatars create videos in minutes and could expand into civic education, though experts warn about clarity, bias and making disclaimers more prominent.
